

Report of Health Camp



On 26th February 2017, in the Institute of Social Service, Kolad, Raigad along with the students of College of Social Work, Nirmala Niketan organized a free Health Camp for the tribal of around 25 hamlets. Doctors from Mahatma Gandhi Mission (MGM) Hospital, Vashi collaborated with the students of Nirmala Niketan and provided free service very efficiently.

The camp was started by registration and welcoming of doctors and their team, they introduced themselves and gave assurance that tribal people would get free treatment at Vashi Hospital but they need to just carry Aadhar card/ration card. They also offered free surgery at MGM, Vashi and additional treatment to these tribal people those who are BPL. They provided general health, blood pressure, pediatric, gynec, ENT, eyes, sugar, orthopedic checkups. Camp was started at 10.30 am and went on till 3.30 pm where around 250 people benefited from this Health Camp and were also provided with medication.
