Education- Due to migration in the supplementary classes the attendance of the children is very low. For the present children we take different activities like drawing competition, essay writing, general knowledge etc. The present children were also motivated to go to school, and take the benefits of the mid day meal. The aganwadi also being visited and the food was supervised, it was notice that in some aganwadies food was not prepared according to the menu given by the ICDS department. (Integrated child development scheme). The complaint was file to the department.
